## Manufacturer's Certification

Norman® Window Fashions ("Norman®") hereby certifies that its **Woodlore® shutters**, when used in conjunction with double-pane, low-e glass windows, meet applicable energy performance standards as identified in the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) for U-factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient for all climate zones, and each qualifies as an "Eligible Building Envelope Component" that qualifies as an insulating system that is specifically and primarily designed to reduce heat loss or gain in a principal residence, and qualifies for a Federal Tax Credit for tax year 2025 as a non-business energy property under Internal Revenue Code Section 25C in the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, for a tax credit equal to **30%** of the purchase price of qualified products, up to a maximum annual amount of **\$1,200**, not including measure and installation, through December 31, 2032.
